



Gyeonggi Province's Strategies for Post COVID-19 Era

This study aimed to forecast the changes in the times after COVID-19 and to present active response strategies and tasks in Korea and Gyeonggi Province. First, the prospect of what kind of changes will be caused to the existing world order and socio-economic system due to COVID-19 was presented.

COVID-19 is causing fundamental changes in the modern global society operating system, including international order, political security, socio-economic system, urban lifestyle and spatial environment.

First, in the process of reaction to COVID-19, changes in the international order were remarkable, such as the blockade of borders, the control of strategic materials such as health care, and the weakening of the international cooperative system.

Second, in the process of preventing COVID-19 infection, real-time monitoring of all people based on IT technology became possible, increasing the possibility of infringement of basic rights.

Third, the 'untact industry' has rapidly emerged due to the widespread introduction of non-face-to-face means to block infections

that occur in urban life and business processes such as schools, companies, factories, and distribution, which is a factor that promotes the ongoing 4th industrial revolution.

Fourth, the importance of the health and medical sectors that can block, prevent and treat infectious diseases has increased, and has emerged as a function of national security strategy.

Fifth, the changes in industry, economy and lifestyle caused by COVID-19 intensively impacted the vulnerable groups such as self-employed, daily workers, and freelancers in cities, causing social problems such as deepening income gap and increasing unemployment.

In the study, 17 tasks were presented in the 5 strategies that Gyeonggi Province should pursue first in the post-Covid-19 era.

Strategy 1 In order to create a “safe community from infectious diseases”, three tasks were proposed, including the establishment of a regional quarantine system.

Strategy 2 In order to “lead a new paradigm in the post COVID-19 era industry,” four tasks were proposed: the combination of the 4th industrial revolution and the untact industry, and strengthening the global leadership of the K-bio industry.

Strategy 3 In order to “build a job-welfare system that is resistant to external shocks”, four tasks were proposed: measures to resolve unemployment and unstable labor problems, change the structure of alleys, and spread the basic income system.

Strategy 4 For the “post COVID-19 era city and lifestyle transition”, the culture-leisure style of the untact era, shifting the educational paradigm, revitalization of transport and personal means of transport resistant to infectious diseases, and building a sustainable

ecological-energy system Presented the task

Strategy 5 To “strengthen K brand and global leadership in the post COVID-19 era”, two tasks were proposed: reinforcing global leadership in the post COVID-19 era and preparing a breakthrough in inter-Korean relations through strengthening cooperation in quarantine/health care.

By actively responding to the transitional period brought by COVID-19 through the implementation of strategic tasks, we will be able to create a safe and stable life and a vibrant economy for the citizens of Gyeonggi Province. The indicators of the 17 tasks of the five strategies in the post-Covid-19 era and the annual implementation plan were presented.
